Job Title: Meals on Wheels Program Assistant

Service Location: 247 North Macdonald Street, Mesa, AZ 85201 **Department:** East Valley Adult Resources – Meals on Wheels

Supervisor: Director, Meals on Wheels

Schedule: Average 18-20 hours per week, with specific schedule to be developed subject to needs of the program.

Service Commitment: Must complete 950 service hours. **Service Term:** September 1, 2017 to August 31, 2018

Department Summary: East Valley Adult Resources (EVAR) has been dedicated to empowering and supporting older adults and their families to remain independent and engaged in our community since 1979. EVAR provides a full continuum of programs and services, with core programs that include: Center-Based Services at two Active Adult Centers (senior nutrition congregate meals, health and wellness support, education programs, and social activities); Meals on Wheels (daily hot, nutritious meal delivery and wellness checks for homebound older and disabled adults), In-Home Support (Assistance for Independent Living Volunteer Services matches isolated homebound older adults with volunteers for essential transportation, grocery shopping, friendly visits and related supports; Home Care provides non-medical respite, personal care, and homemaking services through trained home care aides); and Outreach / Social Services (assistance in navigating and accessing needed social services, benefits and health resources). The overarching intended outcome for older adult participants is to maintain independence, preserve dignity and enhance quality of life.

Job Description: Within the scope of the organization's mission and as part of the Meals on Wheels Program Team, the Program Assistant is responsible for assisting with program operations, meal delivery, program promotion, and volunteer recruitment to enable homebound older and disabled adults to remain safely independent in their own homes.

Essential Duties/ Responsibilities:

- Complete training to become knowledgeable about Meals on Wheels and the full array of EVAR's programs.
- Work with the Director and staff team to support program operations, including but not limited to: conduct
 wellness checks on participants, deliver meals, connect participants with other EVAR services, respond to
 participant calls for schedule changes and other needs, assist with logistical changes to delivery routes and
 driver schedules, and data entry of participant and service information as assigned.
- Promote program options for transitional frozen meals (Meals While You Heal) and private-pay hot meals (Meals For You) in alignment with EVAR's branding and outreach plans.
- Assist the Director and the team in recruiting and training volunteers. Plan and implement volunteer recognition events and activities.
- Maintain accurate records of participants, services, and volunteers in accordance with EVAR procedures.
- Assist with other Meals on Wheels and EVAR Core Program activities as needed and appropriately assigned.
- Ensure that EVAR's policies, standards and decisions are implemented and maintained in service provision.

Education/Experience/Qualifications:

- Experience working with older or disabled adults and sensitivity to their needs.
- Effective interpersonal skills and ability to encourage teamwork. Multi-cultural sensitivity and ability to work with diverse community members.
- Excellent customer service skills.
- Ability to work independently and proactively with participants.
- Strong organizational skills. Computer literacy.
- Flexibility to work special activities or events as assigned.
- Reliable transportation to use in the performance of some job functions. Valid Arizona Driver's License and automobile liability insurance coverage.
- Ability to life up to 25 lbs.; ability to sit or stand for long periods of time.
- Preference will be given to candidates who are 55 years of age or older
- U.S. citizen or U.S. National or have status as a Lawful Permanent Resident Alien
- Member must successfully pass a background check by Mesa United Way
- Have ability to obtain/maintain a DPS fingerprint clearance card
